Glenelg is a great place for walking. Catch the sea breeze, enjoy the flat terrain as you explore Glenelg's history and public art. Reward yourself at the end of the walk with a rest at one of the numerous cafes or bars or on a bench along the beach.

THE WALK STARTS AT THE TOWN HALL IN MOSELEY SQUARE

The full walk (nos 1-85) takes about 3½ hours. The Early Glenelg route (nos 1-42), the Glenelg Village route (nos 1-11, 43-58) and the Mansions of Glenelg route (nos 1-11, 59-85) take about 1 hour each.

Please respect the privacy of homes along the way.

All walks are accessible for wheelchairs or scooters.
