



## Heathland Hike

2.5 km loop \*1 hr loop

Starting from either the Haines Road car park or the eastern boundary gate, this short hike traverses dense mallee eucalypt heathland, with an abundance of acacias, banksia, tea-tree and hakea.



## Eucalypt Hike

2.5 km loop \*1 hr loop

Starting from the eastern boundary gate this short hike passes through South Australian blue gum woodland with several species of native grasses including the rare short wallaby-grass. Western grey kangaroos are often found grazing in abundance.



## Native Grasses Hike

5.5 km loop \*2 hr loop

Starting from either the Haines Road car park or the eastern boundary gate, this hike traverses both the dense mallee eucalypt heathland and SA blue gum woodland of the park. Keep an eye out for a diversity of birds: over 80 species of birds have been recorded in the park including yellow-tailed black-cockatoos, rainbow lorikeets and galahs.

\*Time is generously estimated for an average walking speed of 3 km per hour - allow extra time for resting and sightseeing.
