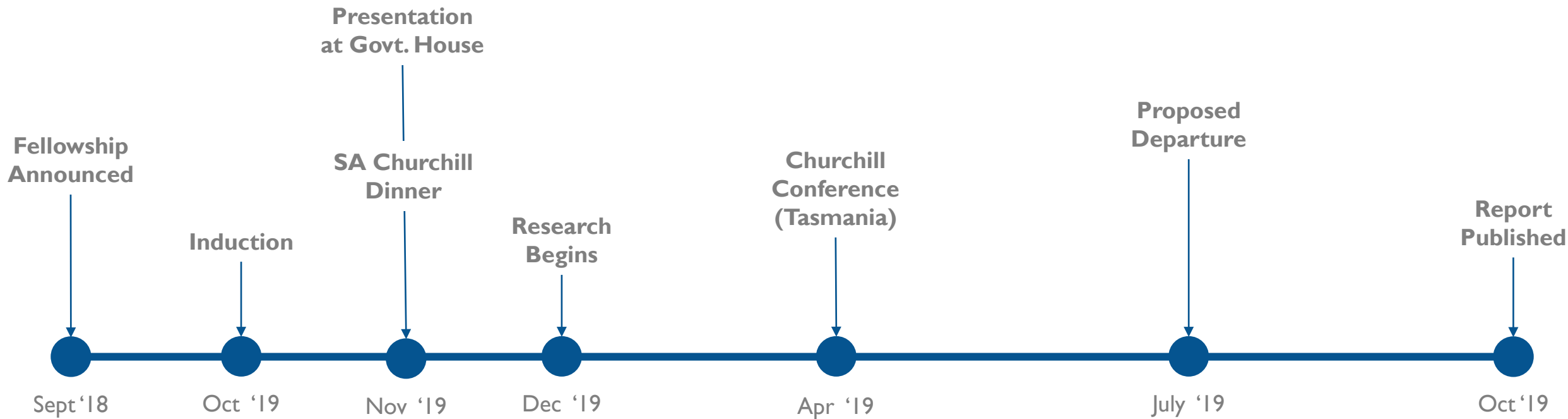
How outdoor trails can be developed, improved, managed and promoted.
