As a key member of the Walking SA Board, the Treasurer oversees the financial operations of the organisation, prepares financial reports and provides strategic financial advice that continues to grow Walking SA.

The role of Treasurer is well supported by an executive, whom undertakes the day-to-day financial transactions of the organisation and provides key governance functions on behalf of the Board. The Treasurer and Executive provide complimentary contributions to ensure the financial integrity of Walking SA accounts. Walking SA uses the Xero accounting system and knowledge of this system is desirable.

Board meetings are conducted every second month. The Treasurer is also a member of the Funding & Finance Committee, that meets quarterly. Annual Reports and Financial Statements of Walking SA can be found on our website.
